IHM PARISH COUNCIL MEETING NOVEMBER 14, 2018

Present were: Father Bob Sims, Council members John Creamer, James Gilroy, Ellen Healey, Beth Leonard and Erin Lewis, Finance Council member Jim Elias, and staff member Anna Harvey.

President-Elect Beth Leonard opened the meeting at 7:07, as President James Gilroy's arrival was delayed due to travel. He initially participated by phone. The minutes of the October meeting were approved and will be communicated through the parish web site.

Father Bob related that the Council had been asked for input on the choice of a recipient for the Spirit of IHM award in parish activities. A brief discussion followed. A formal recommendation was not required or given. The suggestion was made that each person who had been recommended for the award but was not chosen be sent a private note from the Spirit of IHM Committee that he or she had been nominated. Father also reported that in the future different staff members would attend Council meetings depending on the matters discussed. Ronda Swartz, Principal, Anna Harvey, Business Manager, and Kyle Murphy, Youth Minister, would be present as appropriate.

Anna Harvey outlined the PICA Archdiocesan audit which occurred on October 29-30. No material problems were noted. She also said that a process is being set up for how to approve various projects in the parish. The subject of use of the IHM logo continues. Copyright is not a problem, but more uniformity in its use is desirable among various groups planning to use the logo. Permission might be required if a somewhat different logo is desired by a group. Erin Lewis and Jim Elias will develop a policy for the Council to consider, to be reported at the December meeting.

Reaction to the E-Blast to the parish was very favorable for the annual report and the financial report. The survey summary could have been more detailed Comments were made about the need for a directory, which has not been revised since 2015. Privacy concerns were raised. Anna will investigate more and report at the January meeting.

James asked about the results from the fall festival, which had been hampered by rain. Even though the run was canceled, sponsorships were strong, and a net of \$66,000 is expected. Organization overall was effective. A meeting of North Deanery parishes who have festivals is planned, to share ideas for future events.

Erin raised the question of more opportunities to increase stewardship. Anna said quarterly notices in some form might be offered.

James arrived at 7:40. Ideas for areas of Council concern followed.
