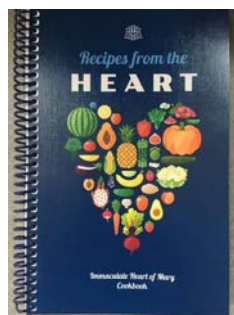
Love in Deed

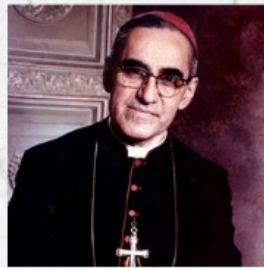
