St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry Need Your Help

Currently, a very dedicated group of 20-30 volunteers from St. Mark's volunteer every Wednesday morning at the Food Pantry on 30th Street. We rely on them to repackage produce and frozen meat products. Due to the fact we have been fortunate enough to receive an abundance of produce and meat lately, this group has been asked to also volunteer their time on Thursdays. While the group from St. Mark's has been most generous with their time and talent, we believe it is unfair to expect them to continue at this rather vigorous pace.

We would like to expand this wonderful opportunity to the IHM Parish. There are at least two options for us to pursue:

- Have one group of 20-30 volunteer every Thursday from 7 or 8 AM until noon; or
- Join with four other parishes, each with a group of 20-30 who volunteer one Thursday each month. Four parishes would volunteer the same week each month and the fifth parish would volunteer on the fifth Thursday in the months there are four Thursdays, i.e., January, May, August and October in 2019.
- So, why would the IHM Parish want to do this?
- God wants us to take care of our neighbors and make certain everyone has the opportunity to obtain more nutritious food. By repackaging produce and meat, God will know you are doing your part in the well-being of the people we serve.
- God wants us to have a sense of community. The volunteers from St. Mark's have formed a special bond among them as a result of this volunteer opportunity they do together. Through this service opportunity, strong friendships have formed and many go out to lunch together once their labor is complete.
- God wants us to share the burden of others. St. Mark's would be so grateful for others who step up to the plate and have offered to train all the new Thursday volunteers as a token of their appreciation.

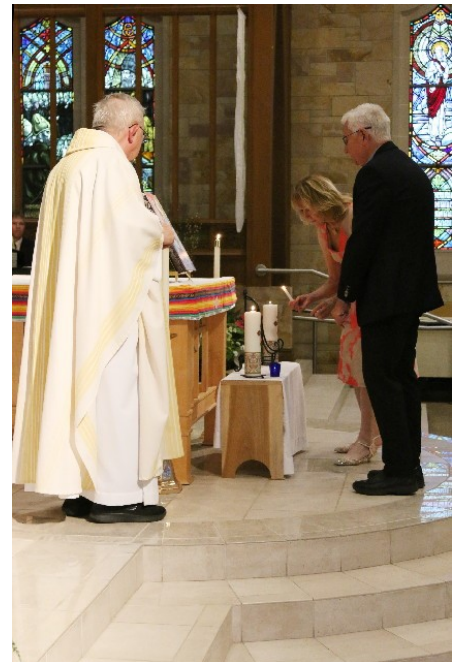
