

Outreach Corner

Catholic Accompaniment and Reflective Experience

Catholic Social Teaching defines Rights and Responsibilities in this way: "Catholic tradition teaches that human dignity can be protected, and a healthy community can be achieved only if human rights are protected and responsibilities are met. Therefore, every person has a fundamental right to life and a right to those things required for human decency. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities—to one another, to our families, and to the larger society." The Catholic Social Teaching Principles of Migration include:

- People have a right to find opportunities in their homeland.
- People have the right to migrate to support themselves and their families.
- Sovereign nations have a right to control their borders.
- Refugees and asylum seekers should be afforded protection.
- The human dignity and human rights of undocumented migrants should be respected.

During his keynote address at the Parish Social Ministries convening in the fall of 2018, Archbishop Thompson spoke about the danger of living in a culture of seeing through the eyes of "either/or", instead of a culture that emphasizes "both/and". He got straight to the point when he asserted that when we live in a culture of "either/or" or "black and white", we can fall into the temptation of forming judgements that may close our minds and hearts to learning from each other, which eventually can translate to the start of demonizing each other. We are called to uphold the dignity of all people, but to do that there will be times when we will need to stand in the *breach of the divide*, which can be filled with challenges and tension.

The newest Catholic Charities - Social Concerns ministry called CARE (Catholic Accompaniment and Reflective Experience) is a great example of standing in that *breach of the divide*. The CARE Program is committed to connecting Catholic volunteers and parishes with fellow community members who are undocumented immigrants, unaccompanied children, and their families in need of accompaniment and emotional, social service, and spiritual support when integrating into their communities or attempting to comply with immigration laws and policies.


