Connect2Help Needs Your Help



Connect2Help is the information and referral call center that answers the local 211 calls (basic/social service needs calls) as well as the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline calls for Central Indiana. Our mission is to facilitate connections between those who need human services and those who provide them. We have been helping persons in need as a stand-alone nonprofit for over 32 years. Our 24/7 center is located in the Meridian Kessler neighborhood of Indianapolis.

NO EXPERIENCE IS REQUIRED! Connect2Help is looking for interested community members to help us with our suicide and crisis calls. Each volunteer will be provided with free training on how to help our callers and direct them to the level of care best suited for their needs. Our next 40-hour volunteer training will be held in late July 2019. We will ask our trained volunteers to help us a few times a month, as it is convenient with their schedule. Other trainings will be available later in the summer.



Our training will give the crisis volunteers all they need to assess their callers, practice active listening, how to reflect empathy and how to provide referrals to meet their needs. Many of our callers just need someone to listen and to care. Would you like to help us? See our website for the volunteer application. 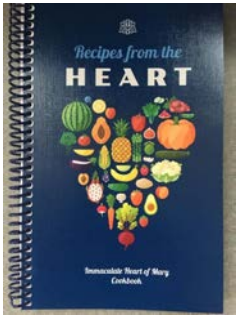
