

## IHM to Offer CHANGING LIVES FOREVER to Address Systemic Poverty

"Give a man a fish, and you feed him for a day. Teach a man to fish, and you feed him for a lifetime."

Changing Lives Forever is a 9-week class on Mondays and Thursdays to help individuals living in poverty to find resources and develop a plan to improve the quality of their lives. Once participants have a plan, mentors will work with each participant for a year to help them to achieve their goals.



In the process participants will also develop a support network with others in their group.

The program is based on the <u>Getting Ahead in a Just-Gettin'-By World</u> book written by Philip E. DeVol. It has been running successfully at the SVDP food pantry in Indianapolis since 2011. In order to reach more people in need, SVDP asked that the program also be offered throughout Indianapolis.

For the third year, Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish will offer the program on the north side of Indianapolis at the Martin Luther King Center on 40<sup>th</sup> Street. It will begin Monday, September 9th. The program is free and open to all.

testing were available to attendees. 65+ volunteers donated their time to help serve the St. Anthony and Haughville community members. It was a great event and we are very thankful for the parish's support!





Did you know that Bishop Chatard enrolls international students? During the school year, these students live with local families who provide meals, transportation and loving support, for which they receive monthly compensation.


