

IHM to Offer CHANGING LIVES FOREVER to Address Systemic Poverty

"Give a man a fish, and you feed him for a day. Teach a man to fish, and you feed him for a lifetime."



Changing Lives Forever is a 9-week class on Mondays and Thursdays to help individuals living in poverty to find resources and develop a plan to improve the quality of their lives. Once participants have a plan, mentors will work with each participant for a year to help them to achieve their goals. In the process participants will also develop a support network with others in their group.

The program has been running successfully at the SVDP food pantry in Indianapolis since 2011. Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish will offer the program on the north side of Indianapolis at the Martin Luther King Center on 40th Street. It will begin Monday, September 9th. The program is free and open to all.

Outreach Corner

Volunteer Opportunities at the St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry

The St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry at 3001 E. 30th Street needs volunteers. This is the first of two Outreach Corners about these opportunities. If you have a few hours each week or even each month to help, here are some opportunities:

- Assist shoppers Provide information and restock the meat counter, count shopping basket contents, bag groceries (indoor work), and help clients load their cars (outdoor work), return carts, assist with the bread and free table. Volunteers needed on shopping days: Tues., Thurs., Sat. 7:45am 12:30pm; Fri. 8:45am 1pm; Thurs. 4:45-8pm.
- Donation Sorters Some donated food comes in piecemeal, some on pallets. All of it must be sorted and staged. Canned and boxed good need to be consolidated into bins or shelved. Perishable goods need to be placed in the cooler or freezer, and repackaging of bulk-delivered goods. This is an on-going, everyday activity Monday Saturday.
- Unload Trucks and Store Goods Use two-wheel hand trucks or battery-operated pallet jacks. This is an on-going, everyday activity Monday Saturday.
- Truck Drivers We transport products from food banks and food vendors using 24-foot box trucks (no CDL license required). Volunteers needed Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday 7am 12pm.
- Facility Maintenance We need able bodies for custodial jobs and outdoor work to maintain the Food Pantry facility and its grounds.
