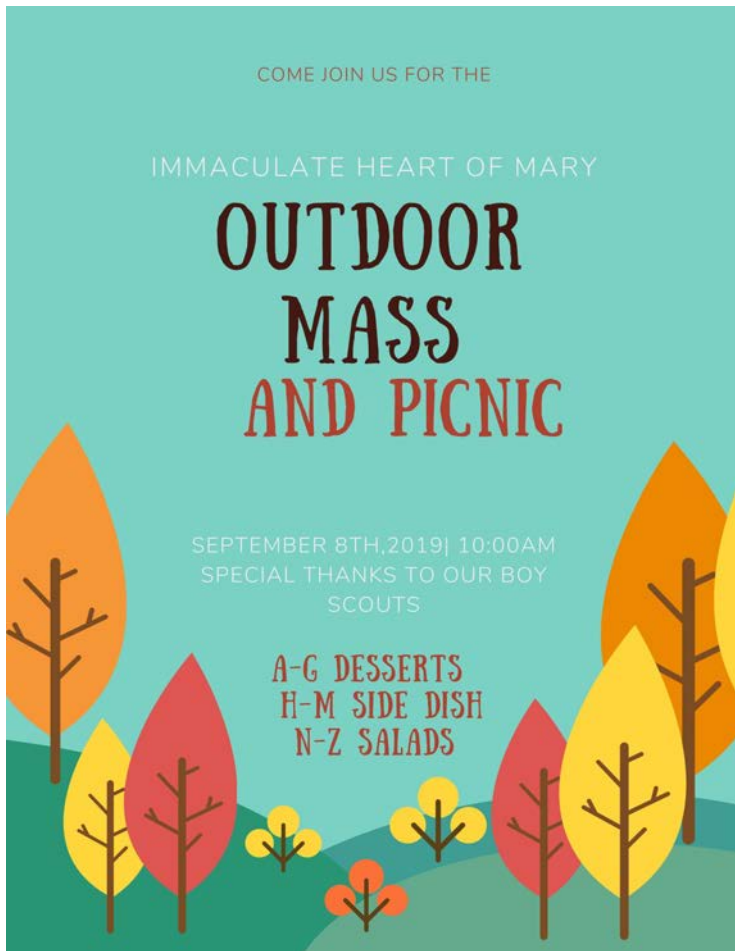


J.O.Y. Club Speaker & Luncheon

IHM to Offer CHANGING LIVES FOREVER to Address Systemic Poverty

Changing Lives Forever is a 9-week class on Mondays and Thursdays to help individuals living in poverty to find resources and develop a plan to improve the quality of their lives. Once participants have a plan, mentors will work with each participant for a year to help them to achieve their goals. In the process participants will also develop a support network with others in their group.



The program has been running successfully at the SVDP food pantry in Indianapolis since 2011. Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish will offer the program on the north side of Indianapolis at the Martin Luther King Center on 40th Street. It will begin Monday, September 9th. The program is free and open to all.

Mentors Needed!

“Give a man a fish, and you feed him for a day. Teach a man to fish, and you feed him for a lifetime.”

Gary Ahlrichs, an IHM parishioner, had always tutored young people before becoming a mentor for an adult in the Changing Lives Forever program. “When I first came to the program, I didn’t know how helpful I could be in mentoring adults because I was unsure of their ability to change at this point”, Gary stated. He adds “Out of all the mentoring and tutoring programs I’ve done, Changing Lives Forever is the best”.

As Gary started mentoring John, Gary did in fact see the changes that John was able to make in a short period of time.

Outreach Corner

Volunteer Opportunities at the St. Vincent de Paul Distribution Center

The St. Vincent de Paul Distribution Center at 1201 E. Maryland Street needs volunteers. This is the first of two Outreach Corners on these opportunities. If you have a few hours each week or even each month to help, here are some opportunities:

- **Donation Processing** - All donated clothing, linens, housewares and knick-knacks must be processed. Sort, hang and price clothing; sort linens, housewares and knick-knacks. All donations are either: 1) given away to clients, 2) sold In Mission 27 Resale Store, or 3) assembled into bundles and shipped to third-world countries. Monday - Saturday.
- **Truck Drivers/Helpers** - 24-foot box trucks go out every Saturday with a driver and a helper to pick up donated items in the community. Trucks are equipped with an electric lift tailgate, 2-wheeled handcart and GPS to navigate to 10-12 pre-arranged stops. Alert driving skills, comfort with this size truck and clean driving record (CDL not required). If you'd rather not drive, ride shotgun and help load the donations. Saturdays 8 am – 12 pm.
- **Unload Donation Trucks** - Donation trucks return to the loading dock around 12 pm on Saturdays. Contents need to be unloaded and placed in the warehouse. Saturdays 9am - noon and noon – 3 pm or whenever last truck is unloaded.
- **Facility Maintenance** - We need able bodies for custodial jobs and outdoor work to maintain the Distribution Center facility and its grounds.

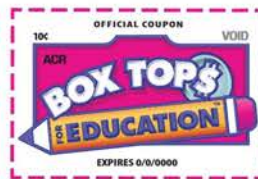
