### The Indy Learning Team

An aspect of Outreach at IHM is to support parishioners doing good work in our community. One such organization is the Indy Learning Team, with Julie Moeller and Pam Renzi from IHM on the Team. The Indy Learning Team partners to provide access to evidence-based literacy training and instruction so students have strong literacy foundation and communities develop literacy resources. Recently IHM Outreach helped to fund an Indy Learning Team literacy workshop at the Martin Luther King Center. The Team had a wonderful Early Literacy Symposium, with four excellent speakers and a very engaged crowd of about 50 participants. They achieved the goals set for the event, and had some positive unforeseen outcomes. Through the Literacy Symposium, the Team provided access to evidence-based literacy instruction and training for parents, teachers and volunteers on how to assess and elevate early literacy skills. They built connections and shared resources to create a reading culture in all communities. They made many outreach connections through personal phone calls, emails and social media - resulting in some


