Changing Lives Forever Update

It is hard to believe that the Changing Lives Forever participants have been meeting for weeks and only have one week remaining!

Thank you to all the cooks who have delivered healthy, delicious meals each week. They have been devoured! Participants have been filling out paperwork to be matched with one of the mentors from IHM. **They are looking forward to meeting their mentors!**



Classwork – What have the participants been learning?

The group began by defining poverty and identifying the causes of poverty. Participants conducted a personal assessment to determine the stability of their living situations. They looked at the following: income versus housing expenses, debt to income ratio, and how their time is spent. Next they discussed the Theory of Change and need to begin to plan for the future. A part of the change discussed was the use of language in work and resolving differences.

Benefits Already Being Seen

The group has bonded and formed a strong support community. They have been able to help one another with finding jobs and problem solving a myriad of issues. One participant summed up the sentiments of many in the group when he thanked the others and told them that they were his inspiration. “When he felt like giving up and not coming that night, he remembered his new friends and headed to the bus to get to class.”

Outreach Corner

Making IHM Outreach even better...please help!

When it comes to outreach, the idea of making a more lasting difference in people’s lives resonates with just about everyone. But how? Two recent talks offer some insight.

In early October, Fr. Jeff Godecker was guest homilist for the Mass honoring the IHM Honduras ministry. In his homily that day, Fr. Jeff asked us how we as Christians can move toward a world of kindness and justice while living in a world of violence, anger, and social inequity. He suggested that “It’s not just about those who serve and those who are served. It’s always a two-way street. Both are givers. Both are receivers. Both are leaders and both are followers in a mutual exchange of gifts. Both are teachers and both are learners.”

Just a few days before Fr. Jeff’s homily at IHM, the Christian Theological Seminary held its annual Fall educational event of the Faith and Action Project at Clowes Hall. The Faith and Action project targets Indianapolis poverty, which is among the most severe in the nation for cities its size. CTS President David Mellott stated that evening that the primary goal of the Faith and Action project is not to provide poverty relief. Rather, it is to eliminate the need for poverty relief. As that evening went on, a distinguished panel of leaders with deep experience shared success stories, all of which were characterized by the same kind of relationship building across boundaries that Fr. Jeff was speaking about.

At this weekend’s Masses, the IHM Outreach Commission will be extending an invitation for YOU to participate in finding a path to even more sustainable IHM outreach efforts. The first planning meeting will take place on Tuesday November 5 at 7:00 PM in the church basement library. Please come to lend your ideas!
