

What is "Leader in Me"? It is an amazing program that has been apart of the IHM School for over 5 years. The students are using the 7 Habits of Highly Effective Kids to take responsibility for their actions and learning. They set goals and reflect on them, volunteer for leadership roles and help to plan and implement activities and programs. We have a Student Lighthouse Team that is required to fill out an application stating what leadership qualities they will use to enhance current programs and new opportunities for the student body. The Student Lighthouse Team gives school tours and are all on committees where they get additional help from students not serving on the lighthouse team. They have played key roles in hosting leadership days highlighting the leadership program, its components as well as serving on panel discussions. Over 130 students in grades K - 8th have taken the lead in teaching lessons, binder presentations, service displays and are also serving as tour guides and classroom guides for leadership days. Students orchestrate leadership activities with their leadership groups or for grades that are interested in learning about or observing a lesson such as science, reading stories, math etc. Leadership behavior has become such a part of student's daily routine observed by staff, other students and visitors. Students yearly are given opportunities to serve and lead including acting as Door Greeters, making bulletin boards, generating ideas for Catholic Schools Week and other celebrations, Mass planning, servers, student readers, student choir, as well as events/jobs in the classroom. IHM students have been chosen to play defining roles at the Leader in Me State Conference which included introducing the keynote speaker where they had to write their own speech. Our school goals are for all students and staff to be reverent, respectful and responsible. A school culture was developed and each class wrote a Class Mission Statement. Students have binders where they write goals, track their learning and their actions as well as their successes. Some special events and activities this year include: a slow school Mass, leadership forum, student baking contest, career day, enrichment cluster, IHM school traditions and new activities that are still being developed by the students.

Outreach Corner Human Life and Dignity

For the Church, there is no distinction between defending human life and promoting the dignity of the human person.

Pope Benedict XVI wrote in *Caritas in Veritate* that: The Church forcefully maintains this link between life ethics and social ethics, fully aware that a society lacks solid foundations when, on the one hand, it asserts values such as the dignity of the person, justice and peace, but then, on the other hand, radically acts to the contrary by allowing or tolerating a variety of ways in which human life is devalued and violated, especially where it is weak or marginalized.

As a gift from God, every human life is sacred from conception to natural death. The life and dignity of every person must be respected and protected at every stage and in every condition. The right to life is the first and most fundamental principle of human rights that leads Catholics to actively work for a world of greater respect for human life and greater commitment to justice and peace.

The bishops pledged to affirm the intrinsic value of human life and the dignity of every human being in a way that transforms the culture by implementing *The Life and Dignity of the Human Person* priority plan.

To achieve this goal, the priority plan includes ongoing education, prayer, policy, and advocacy efforts to mobilize the Catholic community on issues of life, justice, and peace. In this way, the Catholic community celebrates the gift of human life and witnesses to the Good News of Jesus Christ.
