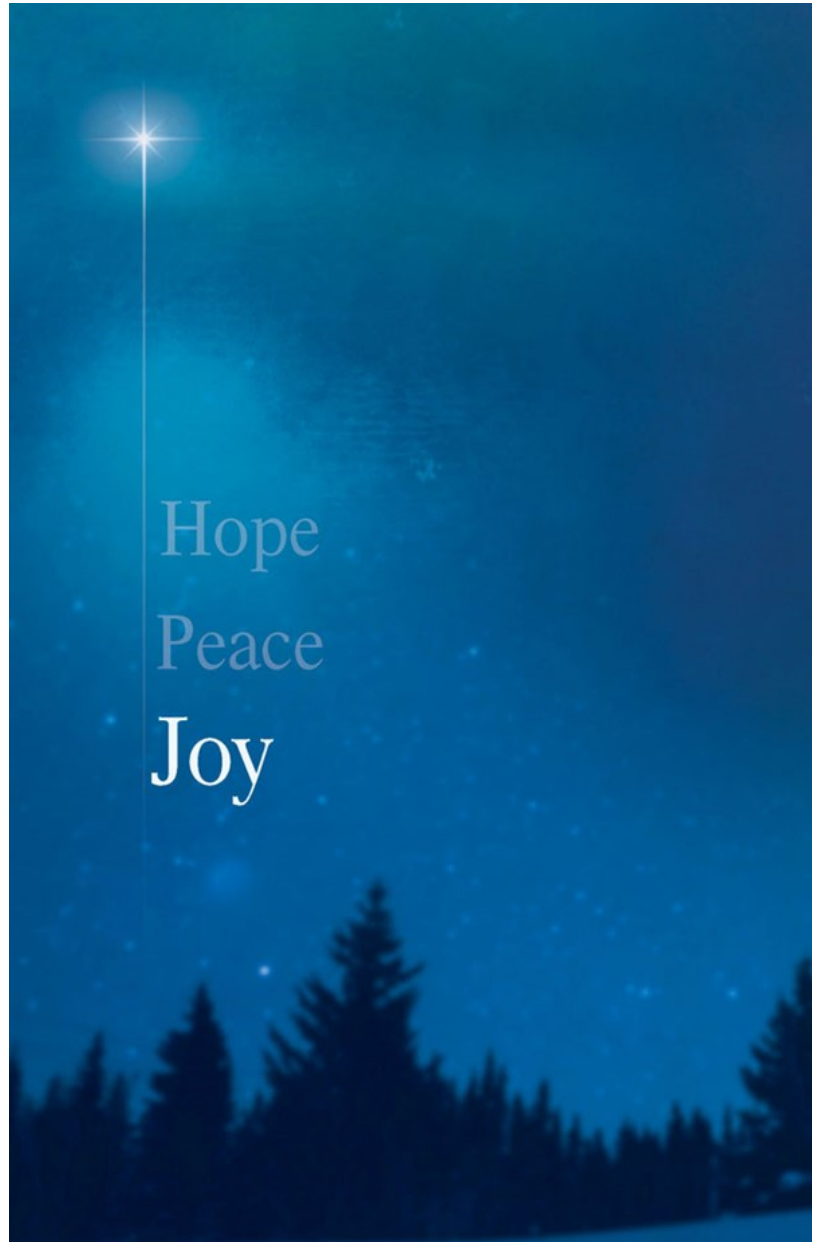

Some Outreach Updates

The St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) **Blanket Sunday** collected 31 blankets for distribution. Thank you to all who donated to this work to help our neighbors keep warm this winter.

The second SVdP **Mission 27** resale shop held its Grand Opening on November 23rd. This store is located at 1618 Shelby Street in Fountain Square. Opening day was a great success, with big crowds, lines out the door, and more than \$12,000 in receipts. Income from the store directly supports the work of the Archdiocese Council of SVdP. The shop neighbors are very happy to see the shop open and add value to their neighborhood. A coffee shop will be added soon also.

The 2019 **Changing Lives Forever** class at IHM graduated eight investigators who completing the 17 classes. This year the class met twice per week in order to complete the work faster and with greater focus. Two of the graduates are now employed at the new Mission 27 resale shop highlighted above. Thank you to all who donated time, talent and meals for these classes.

The Christmas **Boulevard Place** Food Pantry Drive is going on now. Please fill a red pantry bag and return it to the church by December 22nd. The Thanksgiving Food Drive in November collected almost 4000 pounds of food for the pantry. Thanks to all who gave.

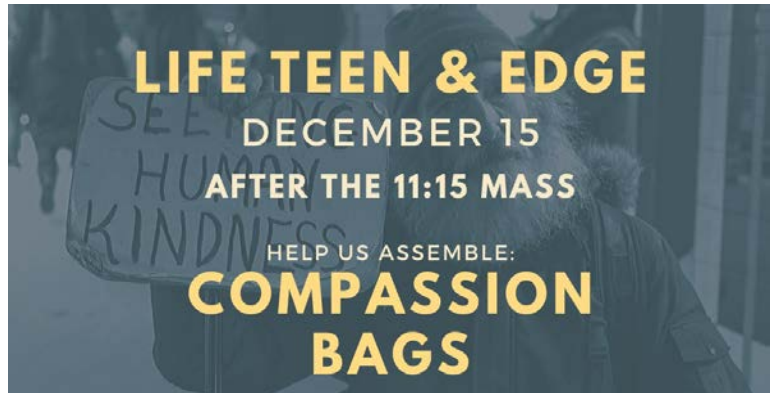

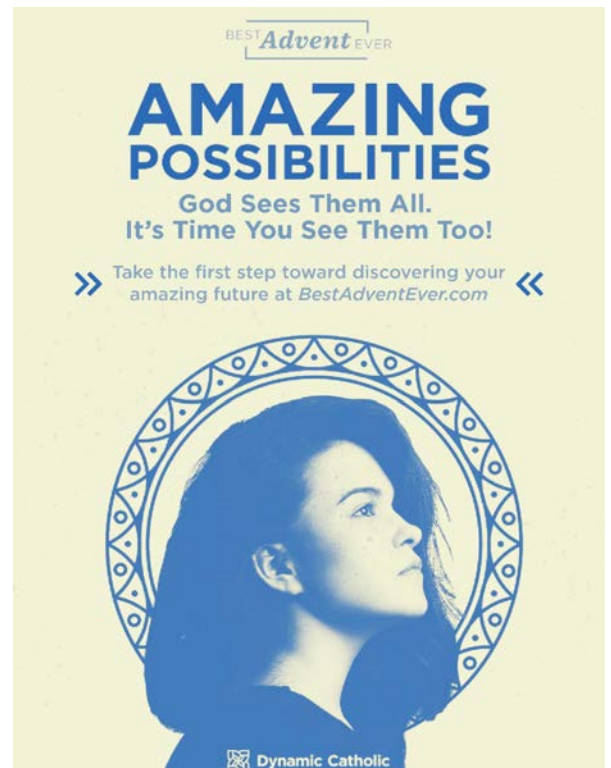

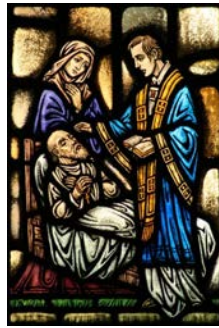
