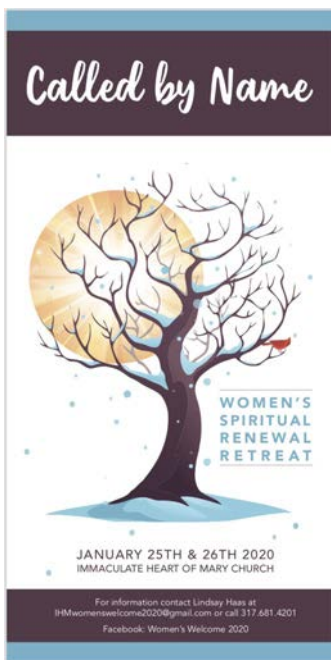
Calling men, fathers, and brothers of IHM: We invite you to join fellow parishioners in a spiritual renewal and gathering of followers in Christ.

Boulevard Place
St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry

Season's Greetings 2019

We are into our eighth year of operation at Boulevard Place which many of you so generously made possible. Overall, the pantry is running smoothly and serving a vital need in our community.

We had 10,518 client visits this past fiscal year, an average of 877 visits per month. We distributed over 475,000 pounds of food and self-care items, a 23% increase over last year. On average, each client shopping at our pantry received 45.2 pounds of food. Using Feeding America valuation statistics, the wholesale value of the goods provided to clients each visit was \$73.22.

Some of our significant achievements in the past year:


- Work has started on the renovation and expansion. We will add approximately 1,500 square feet of space and greatly improve the client and volunteer experience. THANK YOU to all our generous donors for making the remodel a reality.
- The pantry is the proud owner of a 2019 Dodge Ram Pro-master 2500 cargo van. We purchased it used, with low mileage. The van is getting rave reviews for its good looks, stand-up height in the cargo area, increased capacity and improved reliability. We are in the process of getting our logo installed. Our prior van was retired with over 260,000 miles.
- Our five contributing Catholic parishes (Immaculate Heart of Mary, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Luke, St. Joan of Arc and Christ the King) continued to impress with significant direct food and hygiene product donations. The parish donations comprise 12% of all food received at Boulevard Place. We are also fortunate to receive support from other neighboring churches including Meridian Street United Methodist, Mt. Pleasant Missionary Baptist, Unitarian Universalist Church of Indianapolis, and Fairview Presbyterian.
- We continue to partner with the Broad Ripple Farmers Market during summer and winter markets receiving hundreds of pounds of unsold fresh produce from very generous vendors. This ongoing partnership is a vital component of our mission of providing healthy food options for clients.

As we move forward into 2020 we ask for your continued support and prayers in our mission.

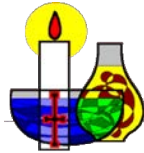

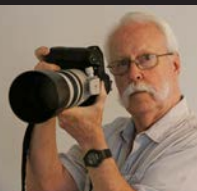
