Sept 15th: Irish Fest down at Military Park; admission is 7 food items –entry is free with donation. Donations go to SVdP Food Pantry on 30th street.

Honduras Mission: Kathy

The **Honduras mission** led three great trips over the summer for 34 young people and about 8 adult chaperones. We did home makeovers (painting inside and out, making repairs, and providing new bedding and kitchenware) for three of the 12 children's homes in Sister Maria Rosa's children's village. We also conducted food brigades, buying and bringing food staples to very poor families and elderly individuals in nearby villages. We held social events for the children, including movie nights, game nights, spa nights, and a carnival with games and prizes. We visited with Sister Maria Rosa and listened to her stories and insights—always a trip highlight!

Anna's House: Anna's House/The Lord's Pantry (Chris) Our 3rd Wednesday dinner numbers continue to be stable at around 75 to 85 people each week. Leticia has been sending out the menu via social media. The next open slot for the 3rd Wednesday dinner is March of 2020.

The food pantry continues to feed 150+ families a week. We continue to pick up from the Walmart warehouse twice a month which is great for volume, but too much packaged goods. We get no fresh fruit or veggies from Walmart. Second Helpings continues to provide great amounts of bread and desserts weekly. Our Kroger pick ups have become hit or miss each week. We need to add some different locations for fresh food to be donated. Let me know if you have any ideas.

Julie Molloy has come back to work full time in support of Leticia after taking some time off. It has been a great re-addition. I am going to roll off the Board of Directors at the end of this year. I have done 6+ years. If you know anyone interested in participating in a great and active board, please let me know. I would love to get more IHM folks involved.
