2. The minutes from the 11/14/19 meeting were approved without comment or correction.

3. Scott provided and update on the Transformational Outreach meeting on Jan 7. Below is a summary of the Vision, Focus and Goals:

<u>Vision:</u> Outreach that transforms IHM - helps us to better utilize our gifts to enable others, and also to understand and improve upon our weaknesses. We will do this by partnering more actively with organizations outside IHM, and by learning and practicing the principles of transformational outreach.

<u>Focus</u>: Poverty Reduction ("making the food line shorter")

- 1. Learn and document the principles of transformational outreach & develop an assessment tool.
- 2. Sponsor educational events to increase IHM knowledge of principles of transformational outreach.
- 3. Help and build upon existing IHM efforts that are already following the principles of transformational outreach.
- 4. Learn more about ongoing poverty alleviation initiatives in Indy, especially near IHM. Explore opportunities to support such initiatives.
- 5. Establish a mutually beneficial partnership with a group outside IHM that helps moves us toward our vision.

4. The Outreach Commission, especially the new Transformational Outreach ministry, will be hosting the Ash Wednesday Soup Supper on Feb 26. Each ministry will have an opportunity to highlight their work.

5. The budget was reviewed, with an emphasis on spending what we have by June 30. St. Vincent de Paul has moved the remaining budget to their operating account. They may need additional funds for the remainder of the fiscal year. One suggestion was to highlight the Changing Lives Forever program on the fifth Sunday collection envelopes.

6. The grant request from the Indy Learning Team for \$750 was reviewed and discussed. The grant was approved without dissention.

8. The new Outreach Ministries trifold brochure was discussed and approved for additional printing with minor changes. The goal will be to pass out copies in all masses during Lent.

**Cathedral Food Kitchen**: IHM's support for this work has been well-staffed during the past several months. Summer requires special support due to vacations and students out of school.

**Honduras mission update**; We have a group of 8 men and 8 women traveling down February 3 to February 10. We are working hard to gather donations—it's always a tight squeeze between the holidays and this trip. We'll have a list of needs in the IHM bulletin soon and flyers at church entrances, with boxes in the vestibules. We are collecting school backpacks (we need about 200), household (Home Makeover) items like sheets, towels, dishes, and pots and pans, and underwear, white and black school socks, and undershirts to help with school uniforms. Also, we inaugurated the Father Jeff Travel Scholarship to help provide financial aid to IHM adults and young adults traveling to Honduras. Father Jeff directed all the funds he received at his 50th Anniversary party to Friends of Honduran Children, who will administer the scholarship: about \$500 to one or two IHM travelers each year. The first scholarship is going to a February traveler who is a first-timer to Honduras and a single dad who wouldn't be able to make the trip without the aid.

**MOMS:** Advent giving tree was another year of amazing, generous support from our parish. We served birth line, and students from 2 schools-St. Anthony and Holy Angels. Adding 150 tags for Holy Angels did not deter at all from the support we have traditionally offered to St. Anthony. In addition, the school PTO provided an appreciation lunch for the teachers at Holy Angels for Christmas and private donors from our parish donated gift cards for each teacher.

**Lord's Pantry/Anna's House**: IHM signed up for another year of providing the 3rd Wed dinner. We are feeding over 150 families every Saturday.
