

Outreach Corner

Enhancing Reading and Literacy Skills in our Community

Recently IHM Outreach gave a grant to the Indy Learning Team to support literacy training held at the MLK Center at Illinois and 40th. Julie Moeller, an IHM parishioner, is part of the Indy Learning Team and sent this report about their first workshop of the year: "I wanted to share some follow-up info about our Read Aloud Workshop, the first of our 2020 series, which was held February 22nd at the MLK Center. We hosted 50 attendees from local preschools, public schools, and after-school programs. Parents, teachers and volunteers learned and collaborated on best practices for conducting the most effective read alouds with children. We discussed the science of reading, the importance of reading aloud, how to se-



lect great books, and how to read interactively to promote student comprehension and expression. Through breakout sessions, we helped attendees use our read aloud worksheet to create their own plans. Finally, we had a representative from The Indy Public Library help with library card signups and questions.

"We were able to offer this workshop to many attendees for free because of the grant provided by IHM. We feel our reach in the community continues to grow, and that we are filling a need that exists for connection and access to high-quality, affordable literacy training. Our next workshop is a 3-session series on using Discipline with Love and Logic at home and in the classroom, to be held in March and April. I will continue to update you on our progress. We are so appreciative of our connection with IHM Outreach and the support you have provided to grow our program!"
