

## **BOULEVARD FOOD PANTRY REOPENING WITH DRIVE THROUGH PICKUP!**

**4 WAYS TO PROVIDE FOOD for OUR NEIGHBORS in need served by our neighborhood pantry!**

- 1. Pick up our yellow Lent Easter food bag under the archway between the church and school**  
Fill the bag with exactly the items requested or very similar substitutions. This will help increase pantry volunteer safety, as it will decrease time the pantry volunteers need to pack the bags!!  
(the volunteers will load the top of our bags with meats, fresh produce, bread and any dairy available)

**Return bags/and or pick up new bags every Wednesday between 9AM-1PM starting April 29 at the archway entrance to church. Food lists are attached! Place filled bags on the rolling 4 shelf cart or yellow cart for the next month or as needed during this COVID-19 era.**

**Fill bags with this exact list: (it should be about 2/3 full)**

- 2 Ramen noodles/pasta
- 2 canned meats (4 small) tuna/ chicken sub: cans of canned corned beef/deviled ham/dried beef
- 2 chunky soups
- 2 tuna helper or rice mixes
- 2 boxes cornbread mix sub: other Bisquick mixes
- 2 cans beans: black, kidney or similar
- 2 prepackaged meals like Dinty Moore
- 2 can meals like mini ravioli, etc.
- 2 bars of soap

- 2. Donate “ready to go pizza” for the patrons at the pantry by donating online at Bryne’s Pizza “GODO” Give One Donate One. They will provide cooked pizza from their food trunk on the pantry location after the patrons pick up their bags via drive through.**  
(this was done at SVdP 30<sup>th</sup> Street already!)
