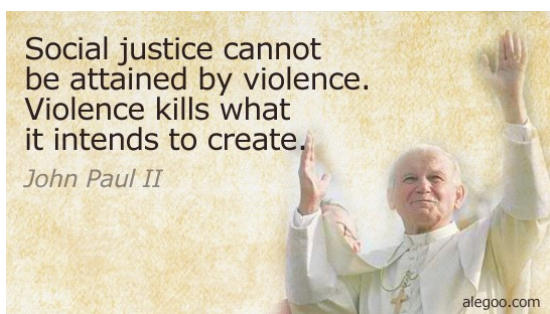

## Welcome Home!

It's been a long time and we are all so excited to be back together! Use the following guidelines to ensure a healthy experience at Mass. If you have questions, please ask an usher.

### Helpful Information:

For now, please only attend your own parish. You are not obligated to physically attend Sunday Mass until August 15.

Please don't come to Mass if you don't feel well.

### When you come, please bring...

Your own hand sanitizer if possible. It's OK if you don't have your own. There will be some at the church.

Your mask/face covering.

### To help keep everyone healthy...

You are asked to use hand sanitizer when you arrive.

We will not be using books or handouts for readings or songs.

### Keeping our Distance...

We are still asked to stay 6 feet away from people we do not live with.

You may notice markings on pews or the floor, this is to help us keep a safe distance.

### During Mass some things may look different too.

We are asked not to hold other's hands during the Our Father prayer.

You may notice too, that there is not a sign of peace.

\*This is only temporary to keep us healthy!

### Receiving Communion...

When you line up, use the floor markings to help keep 6 feet between you and the person in front of you.

We are asking you to receive communion in your hands, not on the tongue.

For safety, the priest will be the only one who receives from the chalice.

### After Mass...

For safety we can't have groups of people gathering, but it is always OK to greet people with something like a wave or a smile.

It might seem strange for now, but we'll learn and be patient together, and God willing we will all be together again soon!

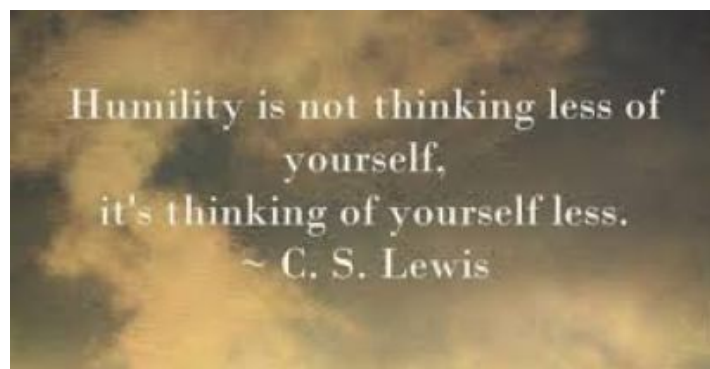

## Outreach Corner

### A Pastoral Letter Against Racism: Wrongs

The US Conference of Catholic Bishops released a document in 2018 entitled “Open Wide Our Hearts: The Enduring Call to Love - A Pastoral Letter Against Racism”. This is the second of four Outreach Corner articles summarizing this pastoral letter via excerpts, with a focus on the wrongs done in our nation.

“With the positive changes that arose from the civil rights movement and related civil rights legislation, some may believe that racism is no longer a major affliction of our society—that it is only found in the hearts of individuals who can be dismissed as ignorant or unenlightened. But racism still profoundly affects our culture, and it has no place in the Christian heart. This evil causes great harm to its victims, and it corrupts the souls of those who harbor racist or prejudicial thoughts.

“For a nation to be just, it must be a society that recognizes and respects the legitimate rights of individuals and peoples. These rights precede any society because they flow from the dignity granted to each person as created by God.”

“We are meant to love God with our whole being, which then overflows into love for our neighbor. ‘Whoever loves God must love his brother’ (1 Jn 4:21)... This is the original meaning of justice, where we are in right relationship with God, with one another, and with the rest of God's creation.”

“The evil of racism festers in part because, as a nation, there has been very limited formal acknowledgement of the harm done to so many, no moment of atonement, no national process of reconciliation and, all too often a neglect of our history. Many of our institutions still harbor, and too many of our laws still sanction, practices that deny justice and equal access to certain groups of people. God demands more from us. We cannot, therefore, look upon the progress against racism in recent decades and conclude that our current situation meets the standard of justice. In fact, God demands what is right and just.”

### Immaculate Heart of Mary Feast Day & Invitation to Pray

The IHM community is invited to pray the rosary on June 20 the feast day of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

On May 13, 1917, near Fatima, Portugal. three shepherd children looked up and saw a "lady dressed in white, more brilliant than the sun." In her hands she carried a rosary. Speaking to the children Our Lady asked them to return to the same spot near Fatima on the thirteenth of each of the next five months. She also gave them a message for all people, saying: "Pray the rosary on the thirteenth of each month to obtain peace." The apparition at Fatima is depicted in the beautiful stained glass window above the IHM front door and the Fatima Shrine.

Our Lady appeared again in the summer of 1917 when the three children returned as directed. Our Lady said, "I will never forsake you. My Immaculate Heart will be your refuge and the road that will lead you to God". In 2020, Saturday, June 20 is celebrated as the feast day of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Please come to pray the rosary at the IHM Fatima Shrine on Washington Street on Saturday, June 20 after 5:30 pm Mass. Please join with other parishioners to remember Fatima and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, patron of IHM parish. (Please wear a mask and remember to social distance).
