

Federal Executions Continue in Terre Haute

The federal government has resumed federal executions this year for the first time in 17 years at the Federal Corrections Center in Terre Haute. Two more executions are scheduled in December. We are now on pace for ten federal executions in 2020, more than double the previous record of four in 1938.

As Pope Francis has made clear, the death penalty is inadmissible as an affront to the Gospel and the dignity of human life. The Catholic bishops have expressed their opposition to the death penalty for decades, and have raised their voices against the death penalty several times since the new federal executions were announced.

As Catholics, we believe that the death penalty is an affront to the Gospel and the dignity of human life. We understand that justice needs to be done when there are serious, even terrible crimes. Victims and their families deserve justice. But we do not need the death penalty to keep society safe or to punish people for wrongdoing. Society gains nothing from these executions. The decision not to execute someone, even someone who has done something terrible, is not 'soft on crime'; rather, it is strong on the dignity of life. The institution of the death penalty is marred by bias against the poor and racial minorities, and many innocent people have been sentenced to death only to be exonerated later based on DNA evidence.

Archbishop Charles C. Thompson is asking Catholics in central and southern Indiana during Advent to pray and fast for the victims who have been killed, the families of the victims, and the inmates who face the death penalty. Please consider supporting a moratorium on the death penalty as a witness to the dignity of human life. 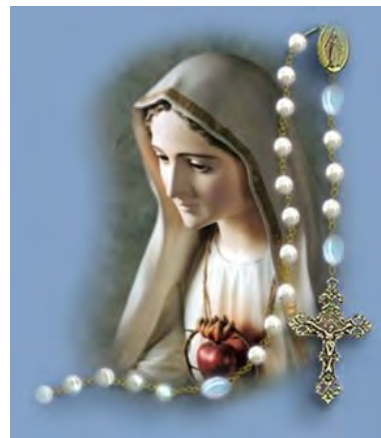
Road to Bethlehem

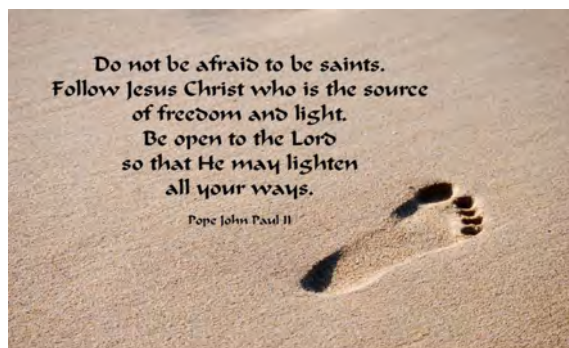
