ACADEMIC

In order to comply with CYO eligibility standards and the internal academic standards for IHM, the Athletic Commission supports the following procedure:

- 1. The principal of each school with a student athlete participating on a CYO sponsored IHM athletic team shall inform the boys and girls Athletic Directors of all student athletes who are ineligible after each academic quarter.
- 2. The principal of the respective school shall inform each student athlete at issue and their parents of their child's ineligibility.
- 3. After each progress report and each academic quarter, the boys and girls athletic directors shall inquire with the principal the status of all previously declared ineligible athletes.
- 4. The principal retains all authority over the eligibility of a student athlete. The decision is not subject to resolution through the Athletic Commission.

CONDUCT

In order to comply with internal behavioral standards at IHM, the Athletic Commission adopts the following procedure:

- 1. If a student is expelled from IHM or their respective academic institution, he or she is immediately ineligible for all CYO practices and games ("CYO Activities") for the remainder of the academic school year.
- 2. If a student is serving a suspension (in school or out of school), he or she is also ineligible to participate in any CYO Activities during the suspension, and shall not return to CYO Activities until they have attended the next school day immediately following the suspension. For example, a student who completes his or her suspension on a Friday shall remain ineligible for CYO Activities over the weekend and until he or she attends school the following Monday (or Tuesday if the school observes a federal or church holiday on the Monday following the suspension). If a student is suspended for a second time within one academic year, he or she is ineligible for CYO Activities for the remainder of that academic year.
- The Athletic Commission Chair, Boys Athletic Director and Girls Athletic Director collectively are the final authority over any issue relating to a student's eligibility for CYO Activities arising from out of a school-imposed suspension or any other conduct-related issue.
