Outreach Corner

An Option for the Poor and Vulnerable

Perhaps you have heard someone say “If people are poor in a country of opportunity and resources, then it is their own fault.” Maybe someone has quoted Jesus’ words that “the poor you will always have with you” (Mt 26:11). It can be easy to place blame on others for poverty, hunger and homelessness. It may even appear to be the ‘natural state’ of life. But poverty, hunger, homelessness are not acceptable conditions for any human being, for any child of God.

In Marion County, nearly one in three children lives in poverty. According to Unite Indy, “While the rate of whites in Indianapolis living below the poverty level is 13.2 percent, for Asian residents it’s 21.9 percent, for blacks it’s 28 percent, and for Hispanics it’s 34.3 percent.” We are surrounded by those who are poor and vulnerable. As Catholics we must act. Among the seven tenants of Catholic Social Teaching, having an Option for the Poor and Vulnerable states that the divisions we see in our community between the haves and have nots, between the well-educated and the under-educated, between races and ethnicities, provide all the evidence we need of the work that we need to do.

These are man-made divisions, created over decades of forgetting that we are all children of God. It is up to us to undo these divisions and erase the barriers that separate people and opportunity. As Fr. Greg Boyle states, we must meet people at the margins. When we see the people at the margins, standing outside our circle, the gospels tell us to go to the margin and erase it. We must stand with the disposable to make sure they will never be disposed of. We must stand with those whose dignity has been denied and whose very existence has been demonized to reaffirm their worth as human beings created in the image and likeness of God.

Lent – Hang in there!

You may have started Lent with great enthusiasm and a list of things you wanted to fast from, add to your life, give away, or prayerfully spend time with. And then you may have discovered that you did not follow through on some or all of them, that giving up your favorite thing makes you so irritable that your family tries to avoid you, or that nothing has really changed.

Or Ash Wednesday came as a surprise to you and you were not prepared and have yet to come up with a plan for Lent. That's O.K. We are not striving for a perfect Lent; we are striving for a faithful Lent. Jesus fell three times carrying the cross. He did not need to carry the cross at all, he did it willingly, in order to give us an example. Follow His example by getting back up after stumbling, by readjusting the weight you put on your shoulder, by accepting someone's help when you need to, but keep moving towards God by letting go of things that keep you from Him, by seeking Him in prayer, and by loving others spiritually and materially. Fast. Pray. Give. The joy of Easter is waiting for you!
