

Catholic Accompaniment and Reflective Experience

Catholic Social Teaching defines Rights and Responsibilities in this way: "Catholic tradition teaches that human dignity can be protected, and a healthy community can be achieved only if human rights are protected and responsibilities are met. Therefore, every person has a fundamental right to life and a right to those things required for human decency. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities—to one another, to our families, and to the larger society." The Catholic Social Teaching Principles of Migration include:

- People have a right to find opportunities in their homeland.
- 2. People have the right to migrate to support themselves and their families.
- 3. Sovereign nations have a right to control their borders
- Refugees and asylum seekers should be afforded protection.
- 5. The human dignity and human rights of undocumented migrants should be respected.

The newest Catholic Charities - Social Concerns ministry is called CARE: Catholic Accompaniment and Reflective Experience. The CARE Program is committed to connecting Catholic volunteers and parishes with fellow community members who are undocumented immigrants, unaccompanied children, and their families in need of accompaniment and emotional, social service, and spiritual support when integrating into their communities or attempting to comply with immigration laws and policies.


