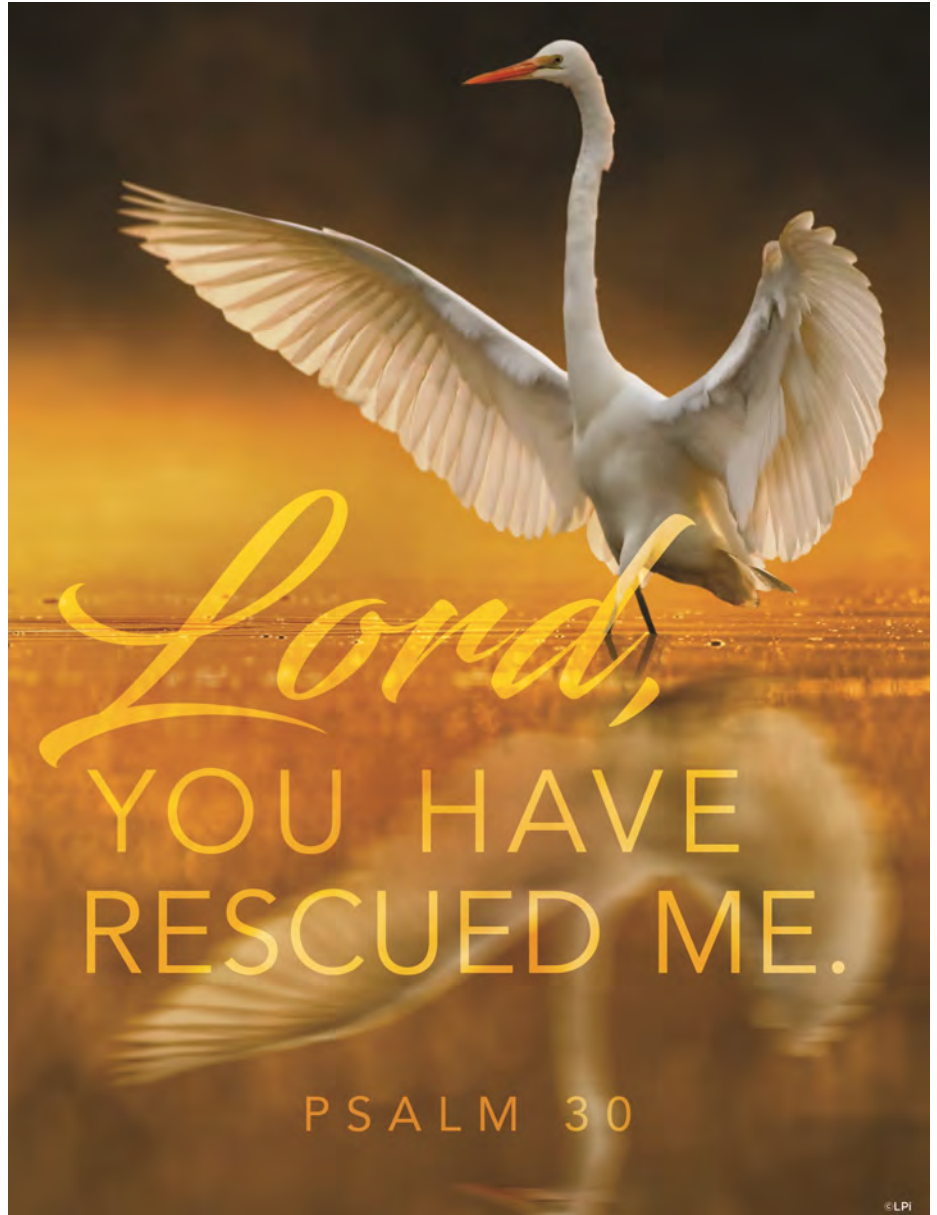

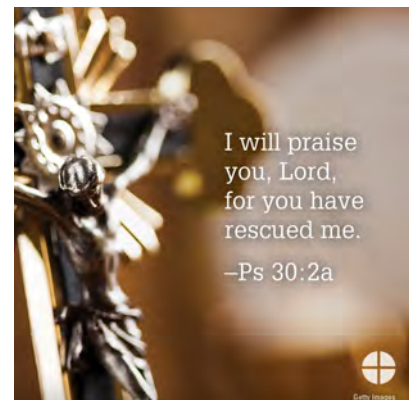

While this is all wonderful and what we have been waiting and longing for, St. Vincent de Paul finds itself critically short of volunteers for the summer months. We hope you and your family, friends and co-workers will consider signing up to volunteer at one of our facilities:

- **Distribution Center 1201 E. Maryland Street** – We need donation sorters of clothing, household items and products, shoes and linens. Also, need able bodies at the dock receiving donations, moving furniture and assisting our neighbors in need.

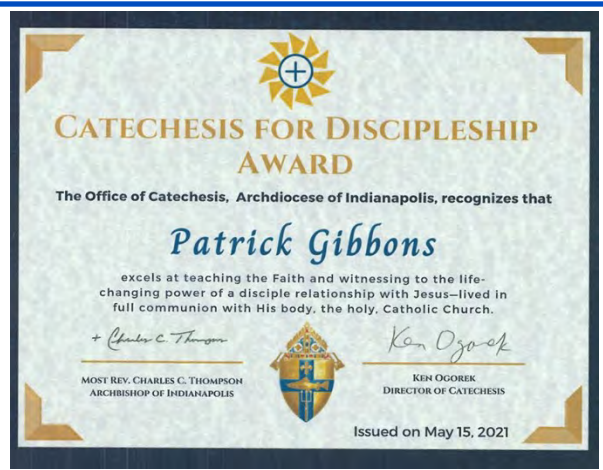
IHM St. Vincent de Paul

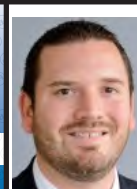
