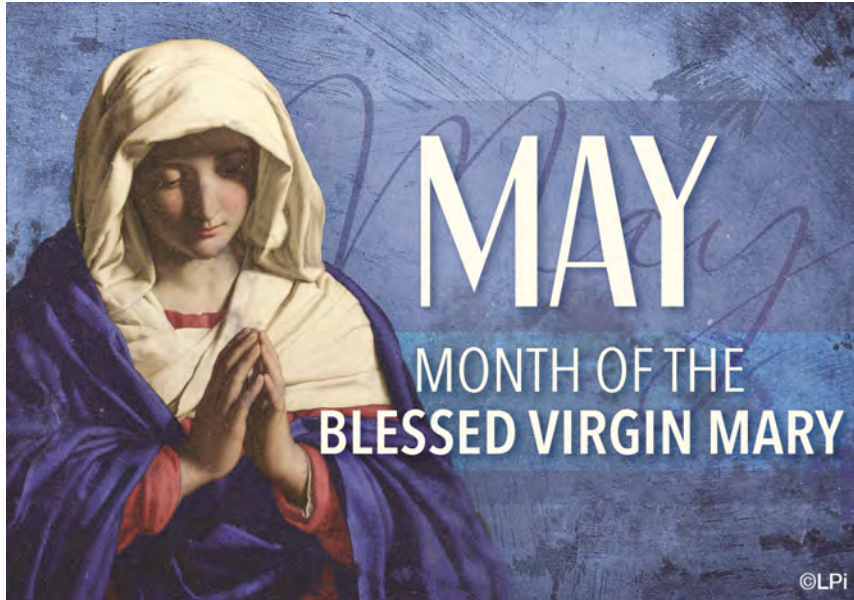


8 o'clock Outdoor Mass

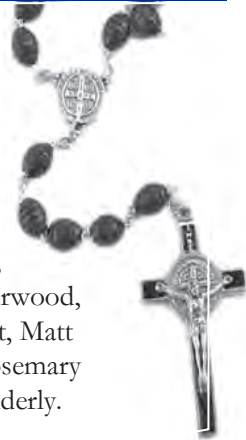
