



#### Confirmation 2023

Confirmation is the third sacrament of initiation into the Church and completes the graces received at Baptism. A confirmed Christian has received the gifts of the Holy Spirit and possesses all the rights and responsibilities of a member of the Church.

ALL high school sophomores in the 2022-23 school year are invited to join IHM's Confirmation preparation program. Parents can register their students online at https://ihmindy.org/sacraments/confirmation/ starting August 6, 2022. The first mandatory meeting for parents and candidates will take place @ 7pm on Sunday, August 28, in the Church. Confirmation itself is scheduled for Wednesday, April 26, @ 7pm at SS Peter and Paul Cathedral.

Our program is utilizing the "CHOSEN" curriculum from Ascension Press. All Candidates will meet together once a month, and in small groups twice a month. A one-day retreat is planned for October 9th (more information to follow). Vital parts of preparing for the Sacrament are regular Mass attendance and being accompanied by a sponsor who functions as a role model in the Christian life.

## **Gospel Meditation**—ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE **August 7, 2022**—19<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

St. Thomas Aquinas reminds us that, "Three things are necessary for the salvation of man: to know what he ought to believe, to know what he ought to desire, and to know what he ought to do." Everyone is called to work toward their salvation, which is ultimately union with God. Those who take this call seriously must embark upon a journey inward to the deepest recesses of their soul. In the adventure and wonder of that journey, we work out the details of our union with our Beloved.
