

Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish has teamed up with SVDP and supported the ministry of Changing Lives Forever Program since 2017. The philosophy of this ministry is to help people in poverty make the first and most important step toward the life they want by taking ownership of their future stories. They learn by using life itself as the context for their learning. SVDP is committed to ending poverty and the Changing Lives Forever ministry as the means to this goal.. The Changing Lives Forever program is based on the Getting Ahead in a Just-Gettin'-By World book written by Philip E. DeVol.. The program has been running successfully at the SVDP food pantry in downtown Indianapolis since 2012, and to date has over 400 graduates and is operating in 10 parishes.

We at IHM have supported this ministry for four years (2017-2019, & 2021) and have 38 graduates. The program is for eight weeks with ten participants (Investigators). Our sessions begin in September on Monday and Thursdays evenings from 5:30pm to 8:00p.m. at the Martin Luther King Center, located at 40 W 40th St. After the eight weeks and 16 sessions, the investigators will be paired up with a "mentor" through the Trusted Mentor program for an entire year for additional advice and support. The program will also assist the investigators in accessing resources at Center for Working Families and Work One.

Confirmation 2023

Confirmation is the third sacrament of initiation into the Church and completes the graces received at Baptism. A confirmed Christian has received the gifts of the Holy Spirit and possesses all the rights and responsibilities of a member of the Church.

ALL high school sophomores in the 2022-23 school year are invited to join IHM's Confirmation preparation program. Parents can register their students online at https://ihmindy.org/sacraments/confirmation/ starting August 6, 2022. The first mandatory meeting for parents and candidates will take place @ 7pm on Sunday, August 28, in the Church. Confirmation itself is scheduled for Wednesday, April 26, @ 7pm at SS Peter and Paul Cathedral.

Our program is utilizing the "CHOSEN" curriculum from Ascension Press. All Candidates will meet together once a month, and in small groups twice a month. A one-day retreat is planned for October 9th (more information to follow). Vital parts of preparing for the Sacrament are regular Mass attendance and being accompanied by a sponsor who functions as a role model in the Christian life.

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE August 21, 2022 - 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

The serious disciple knows the necessity and value of discipline. Thinking of discipline as something punitive in nature, we underscore its place in our spiritual lives. Discipline is really about a radical trust in God and his guidance. "When you are conducted by a guide who takes you through an unknown country at night across fields where there are no tracks, by his own skill, asking no advice from anyone, giving no inkling of his plans, what choice do you have but to give yourself completely to his guidance? If you are convinced that he is a good guide, you must have faith in him and abandon yourself to his care (Jean-Pierre de Caussade)."

If someone wants to be physically fit, they readily find a competent trainer who sets them on a rigorous schedule. Determined to reach their goals, they sacrifice personal pleasure and trust in his guidance. Why should it be any different with God? In order to remain true to the way Jesus places before us, we have to listen, learn, and be willing to change. Falling in love with God and maintaining that relationship requires an investment of time, energy, and hard work. Putting personal preferences aside in pursuit of the Gospel and giving proper attention to our spiritual lives is challenging work. At first, "all discipline seems a cause not for joy but for pain, yet later it brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who are trained by it (Hebrews)."

"What God does is essentially good. It does not need to be reformed or controlled...If you would live according to the Gospels, give yourself completely and simply to the action of God (Jean-Pierre de Caussade)." Submission to the holy will of God is not a submission to a set of pre -ordained set of circumstances. Rather, it is an abandonment and trust in God's creative, life-giving, and salvific power. God brings light out of darkness and life out of death. Nurturing this bond of trust and seeking God in all things creates an intimate and particular relationship and bond between our Creator and us. When He comes, there will be no issue with us recognizing Him or Him recognizing us. We will have met before.
