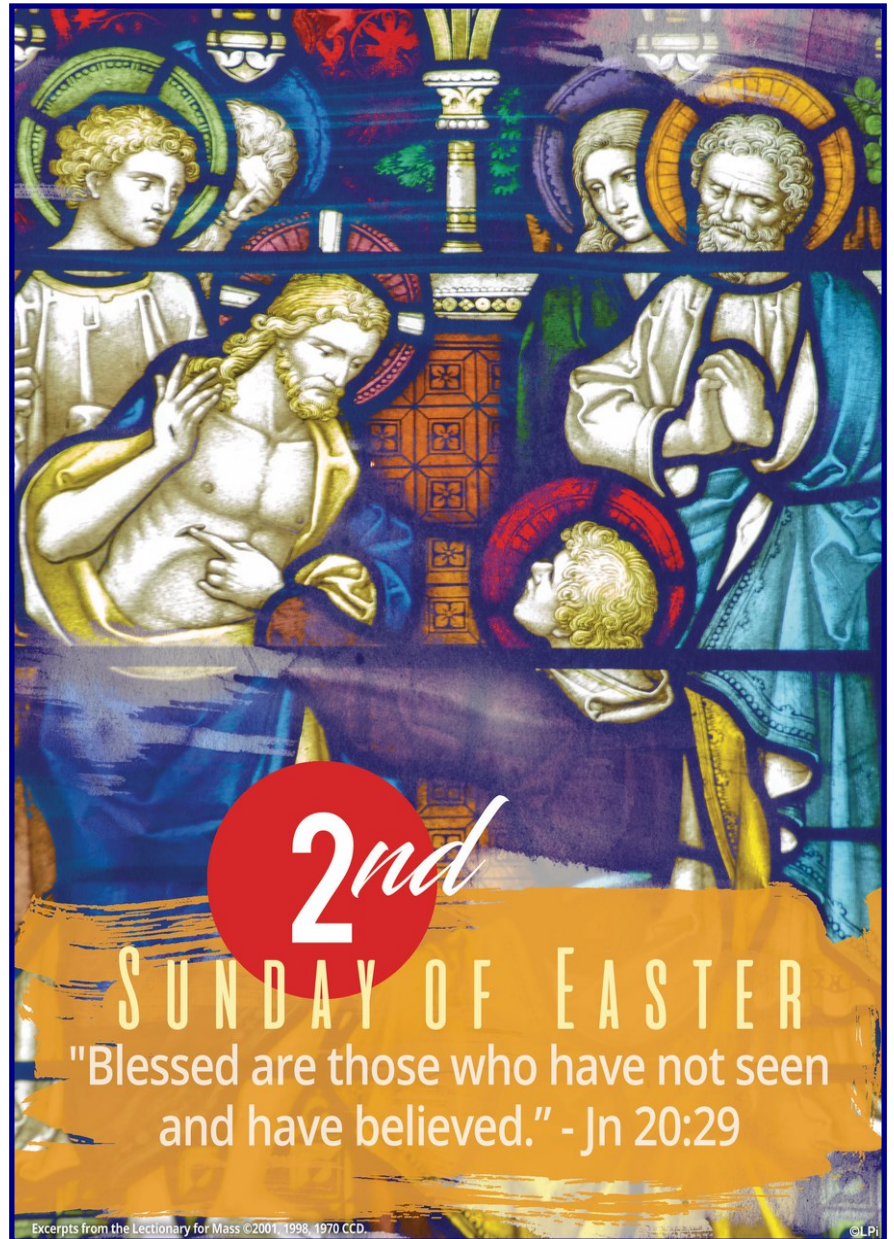

## IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY CATHOLIC SCHOOL

At IHM School, our administration works with our families to meet the needs of every student, and we strive to maintain affordable tuition rates for all families.

In order to assist families, we offer tuition assistance via Indiana Choice Scholarship (voucher) program, Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) scholarships, as well as directly from IHM. In recent years, the State increased the income threshold to allow many more families to qualify for this valuable assistance. In fact, approximately 40 IHM students benefit from the Choice and SGO programs every year.

This year, state legislators are considering further expansions, including another increase in income threshold and the removal of required eligibility pathways. If these expansions pass, choice vouchers will be more accessible than ever. 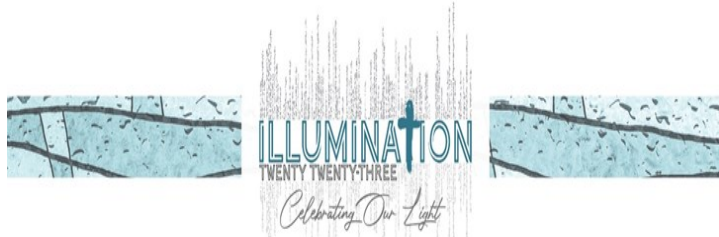

## GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

**April 16, 2023, 2nd Sunday of Easter (Sunday of Divine Mercy)**

A young, engaged couple sat on the couch in front of me as we chatted about their upcoming marriage. The young lady was struggling to trust her future husband. She told me her father had been unfaithful to her mother. She said of her fiancé, "I want him to prove to me that he won't cheat on me." The young man looked at me helplessly, raised his eyebrows and shrugged his shoulders. What evidence could he possibly give to validate such a proof? Nothing. All he could do was invite her to trust him.

We all are wounded by experiences of imperfect love. We also are tempted to demand from God proof of His fidelity and goodness. We are like St. Thomas the Apostle who, on that second Sunday of Easter, demands proof of the Lord's resurrection. "Unless I see the mark of the nail ... I will not believe." Our science, technology and mathematics can indeed prove a great deal. But there are some things that require trusting another person. We prove promises of love only by trusting.

St. Thomas indeed saw the wounds of Jesus and believed. But there is an even greater blessing for us who simply trust Him — and all the truths the Church proclaims — because of the trustworthiness of the Risen One who speaks. This week let's trust Jesus without seeing him.
