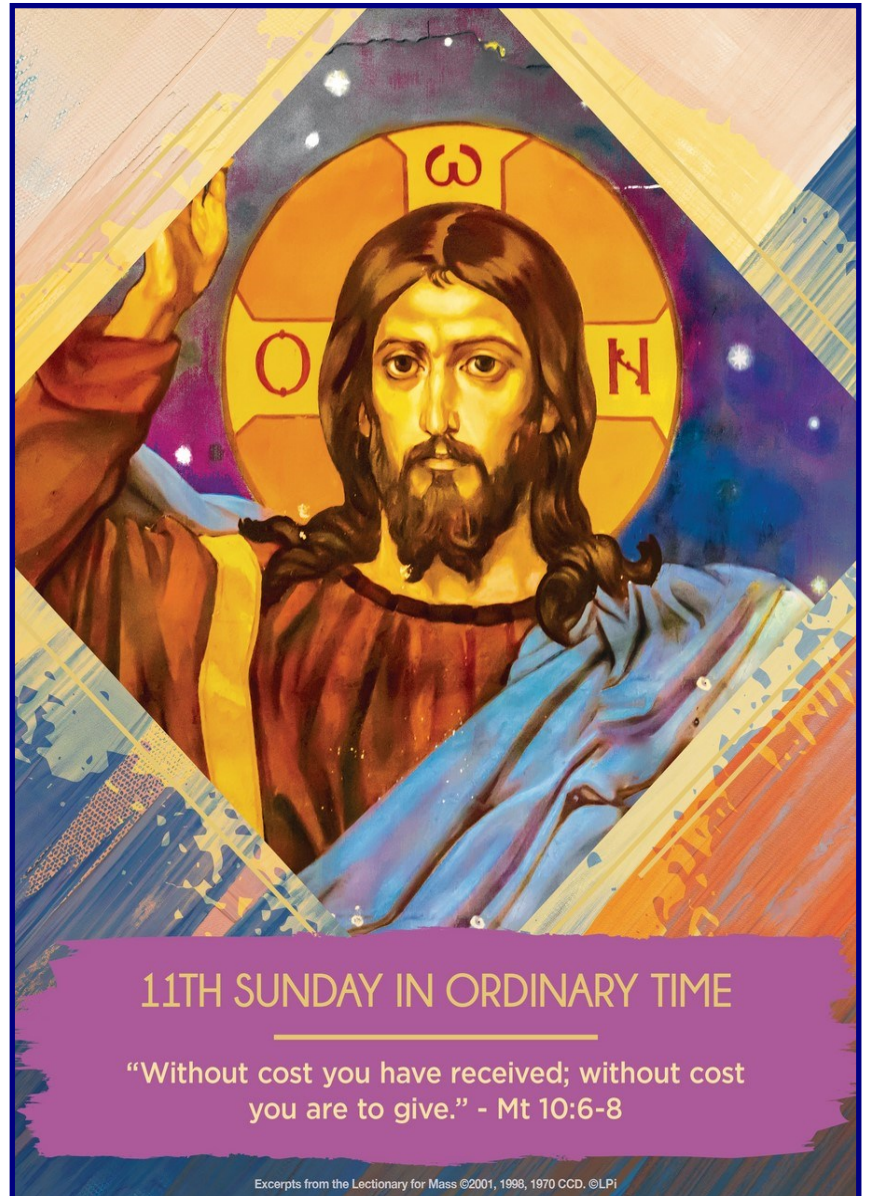

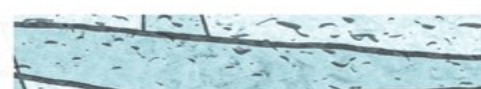

The Pastoral Council of IHM has initiated a program to recognize the work that so many volunteers do to make our parish a community. Profiles of these volunteers are published regularly in the parish bulletin. Our next honoree is Paul Ainslie.

Karen and Paul Ainslie have been parishioners at IHM since 2007. Paul tells his story of reaching out to others:

*My first engagement with Outreach was via the Boulevard Place Food Pantry, which in 2008 was simply the St. Thomas Aquinas Food Pantry. I started in the basement of the STA school helping to stock shelves and assist shoppers. My spouse Karen became engaged with IHM's St. Vincent de Paul Conference, and I joined shortly after. Scott Lowe gave me some insight into the Outreach Commission, which now includes 16 ministries at IHM that strive to serve those in our community, state and world who need some assistance getting by each day. I became the Chair of the Outreach Commission in 2017, helping to coordinate the activities of the various ministries as well as the parish budget for the Outreach group. I still coordinate this group.*

*John Ryan approached me in 2019 and asked me to consider being a candidate for President of the Archdiocese Council of St. Vincent de Paul, a position he had held for the previous six years. John can be very convincing, and I agreed to submit my name as a candidate. In 2020 I was elected the President, assuming the office in October 2020. I am currently in my third year in this role, which includes the 38 counties of the archdiocese and 58 local Conferences throughout central and southern Indiana.*

*When asked why do you do the things that you do? Paul responded:*

*As I neared retirement, I wanted to really become engaged with the many needs I saw in our society. Hunger, poverty, homelessness, mental and physical health, addictions, and dependencies – there are so many issues that need human compassion and energy. And, after all if we are not here to serve, then why are we here? In Matthew 25:40, Jesus says that whatever we do for the least, we do for Him. If we ignore the needy, we ignore Jesus. If we serve the hungry, impoverished, incarcerated, unsheltered, we are serving Him. Seems like a straightforward and meaningful way to serve.*

*My favorite story about volunteering comes from IHM's first Changing Lives Forever program. John, a member of the class of "inquirers," was at the end of his rope, living in his car with little hope. In the first few CLF classes he was quiet and shared little. When he finally opened up, his first words were "I didn't think anyone cared." We can make a difference in someone's life.*

## GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

June 18, 2023 - Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the backyard of the house where I live with other priests, there is a lemon tree which produces a huge amount of fruit. One evening in the spring I needed some lemons for a chicken dish. I glanced from the kitchen and saw the tree bursting with large, bright, gorgeous lemons, hanging thick on seemingly every branch. Turning to Fr. Bob (I'll change his name to protect the innocent) who sat on the couch, I said, "Father, could you pick a few lemons for me?" He said sure and into the backyard he went. He returned a few minutes later empty-handed. "John, there's no lemons. Sorry." I said, "What are you talking about?" I looked again and saw the grapefruit tree on the other side of the yard, which had recently been picked clean of fruit. He didn't see the abundant fruit because he was looking in the wrong place!

Like Fr. Bob, we sadly don't see the fruit all around us. We think that the culture is spiraling down, young people avoid church, and the future looks bleak. Why go out into the world and work? The world looks like a fruitless tree.

Jesus doesn't see things that way. This week he tells us, "The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few." Look again: there is spiritual fruit hanging all around us! The lonely ready to be visited. The sick ready to be healed. The forgotten ready to be remembered. The poor ready to be treated with dignity. The sad ready to be consoled. The young ready for the Gospel. So, let's ask the Lord to send laborers to get to work. And he will. He might send you and me. Just remember to look at the correct trees.

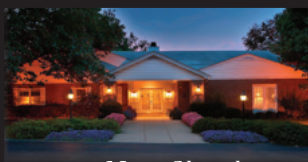
