



## Welcome to Immaculate Heart of Mary - Fr. Pat Beidelman



Patrick Joseph Beidelman was born on September 22, 1972, to Robert and Patricia Beidelman. Fr. Pat grew up as a member of Holy Spirit Parish in Indianapolis and attended the parish school. He later graduated from Cathedral High School and Wabash College, where he pursued a double major in theater and theological studies.

Following his college graduation, Fr. Pat enrolled in Saint Meinrad Seminary. He was ordained to the diaconate on November 1, 1997, and was ordained as a priest by Archbishop Daniel M. Buechlein at SS. Peter & Paul Cathedral in Indianapolis on June 6, 1998. Fr. Pat celebrated his first Mass at Holy Spirit Parish in Indianapolis on June 7, 1998.

Fr. Pat's first priestly assignment was as associate pastor at St. Monica Parish in Indianapolis and chaplain at Cardinal Ritter High School. In 2001, he became the pastor of St. Michael Parish in Brookville and the former Holy Guardian Angels Parish in Cedar

Grove. In 2004, he also became the temporary administrator of St. Mary Parish in Rushville, while retaining his existing assignments. In 2005, Fr. Pat was appointed as the Director of Liturgy in the archdiocesan Office of Worship, as well as rector of SS. Peter & Paul Cathedral. He remained in these roles until the fall of 2007, when he was granted permission to pursue post-graduate studies in liturgical theology at the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross in Rome.

Upon his return from Rome in 2009, Fr. Pat resumed his duties as Director of Liturgy, while also becoming the vice-rector of Simon Bruté College Seminary and providing sacramental assistance at St. Anthony Parish and the former Holy Trinity Parish, both in Indianapolis. In 2013, he was named as the Executive Director of the Secretariat for Spiritual Life & Worship. Fr. Pat was once again named the rector of SS. Peter & Paul Cathedral in 2014, while continuing in his role as the Executive Director of the Secretariat for Spiritual Life & Worship, later known as the Secretariat for Worship & Evangelization. On June 6, 2018, the cathedral parish celebrated Fr. Pat's 20th ordination anniversary with a novena, a special Mass, and dinner. In 2019, Fr. Pat served as priest moderator pro tempore of St. Rita Parish and Holy Angels Parish, both in Indianapolis.

During the summer of 2020, Fr. Pat embarked on a four-month sabbatical, the plans for which were disrupted by the COVID-19 pandemic. His revised sabbatical plans included a silent Ignatian retreat in Massachusetts, a visit to Glacier National Park in Montana, and a visit to Anna Maria Island in Florida. Upon his return from his sabbatical, Fr. Pat was appointed pastor of St. Mary Parish in Indianapolis, while remaining rector of SS. Peter & Paul Cathedral and Executive Director of the Secretariat for Worship & Evangelization.

## GOSPEL MEDITATION July 16, 2023 - 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

It's not uncommon to hear people complain that we Catholics often fail in communicating our faith. Fair enough. We can and should improve there. But it's interesting to notice that Jesus himself was implicitly accused by his disciples of a similar failure. This week in Matthew's gospel they are perplexed that he speaks to the crowds in ambiguous parables. The Lord's riddles leave many people more confused than before. He responds by pointing out that his parables have an intentional dual purpose: to hide (for some) and to reveal (for others) his Gospel: "Because knowledge of the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven has been granted to you, but to them it has not been granted" (Matthew 13:11). Is Jesus being unnecessarily difficult, obscurantist, or, worse, elitist?

No. We have to remember that all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge lie hidden in him (c.f., Col. 2:3). He is the word of God from heaven to be planted in the earth of our humanity to bear great fruit. However, like a lover delicately pursuing his beloved, we're dealing with a relationship, not new data. When we aren't willing to personally accept Jesus into our lives, the "info" of the Gospel will simply not make sense to us. It'll seem bizarre, esoteric, or like incoherent religious-speak. But when we are willing to accept Jesus into our lives, everything else starts to make sense. When others don't understand the Church or the Lord, let's be patient. Love is patient. Sometimes it has to hide before it is revealed.
