Reflection from A Parishioner ~ Thoughts about "Peace in the Mourning"

My husband Dick Tempero died October 24, 2022, and his funeral, officiated by Father Sims, was held at IHM where we have been parishioners for about 25 years. To mark the 1st anniversary of his death, I had accepted an invitation to go on a trip to the Holy Land leaving October 21, 2023. However, with a bombing in the area, my trip was cancelled. Thus, when I had heard about the "Peace in Mourning" retreat for women who lost their spouses at the Fatima Retreat House, I determined that would be a good alternative. Although as for the trip, I had a lot of anxiety and excitement—not knowing what to expect.

After attending the retreat which started the evening of October 20 until noon of October 22, I was thrilled with the experience and as Sister Connie, who coordinated the retreat, said this was my "holy land". Sixteen women were in attendance with some who had lost their husbands this year, others who became widows 5-10 years ago, and others who had attended the retreat 3-5 times previously. Each woman had her own story which she shared. As we were each experiencing grief there was open support for each of us ranging from exercises in forgiveness, ways to take care of ourselves, letter writing, praying, doing grief chair yoga, walking a labyrinth, participating in a guided meditation by Father Jim Farrell who also did Mass. We will continue to stay in touch monthly by zoom.

At the conclusion of the retreat, I felt so good and at peace and would encourage anyone else who has experienced a loss to consider attending this "Peace in the Mourning "retreat which is held annually. The Fatima Retreat House is ideal for a retreat. The grounds are lovely, the rooms very accommodating, an extensive bookstore, and both the staff and food provided by volunteers are terrific. Google "Fatima Retreat House" to learn more about their facilities and programs which are available to anyone no matter your Faith preference Yes, it is a 'holy land' in Indianapolis at 5353 East 56th Street, and I feel privileged to have attended a retreat there.
