- A. School Update Chris Kolakovich
 - a. Chris Kolakovich reported there are only a few days left of the school year, 8th Grade graduation tomorrow night.
 - b. He also reported the 5-Year Strategic Plan for the School is complete. Emily Bannister will share it with the rest of the Parish Council after the meeting. Chris Kolakovich outlined the 6 goals in the plan as well as the strengths of the school that were identified.
