Mass Intentions O & A

Q. Why do we have a "special" intention for Masses?

A. It is an ancient and approved practice in the Catholic Church by which the faithful, seeking to have their special intentions applied to the celebration of the Holy Mass, make an offering to the Church. When we say that a Mass is celebrated 'for' someone or something, it is described as an intention or "special" intention of that Mass.

Q. What is the amount of the Offering?

A. An offering is a contribution made by a member of the faithful for \$10, an amount set by the bishops of Indiana.

Q. Does IHM need more requests for these special intentions?

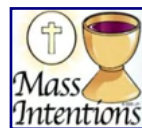
A. **Yes**, Fr. Pat has scheduled a Mass for every day of the week which has allowed us to catch up on demand. We have weekday Masses available from May 16, 2024 on & weekend Masses are available from June 29, forward.

Q. How does a person make this request?

A. You can visit/call/send a note to the parish office, or email churchinfo@ihmindy.org

Q. Why is there a special intention for "The People of IHM" at one of the weekend Masses every weekend of the Year?

A. Fr. Pat and all pastors are obligated to offer one major Mass per week for the intention of the people under their care.

All baptisms take place at one of the weekend Masses chosen by parents. One preparation class for first time parents is required. New parents are encouraged to attend prior to the birth of the child. Godparents are welcome as well. Classes are held the first Monday of February, April, June, August, October & December from 7:30 – 9:00 pm. Please call the parish office for the class you will attend.

Marriages

Engaged couples must start their preparation at least six months prior to the wedding. Preparation includes work with a sponsor couple and Tobit. **A person must be registered & active for 6 months BEFORE plans will be discussed.**
