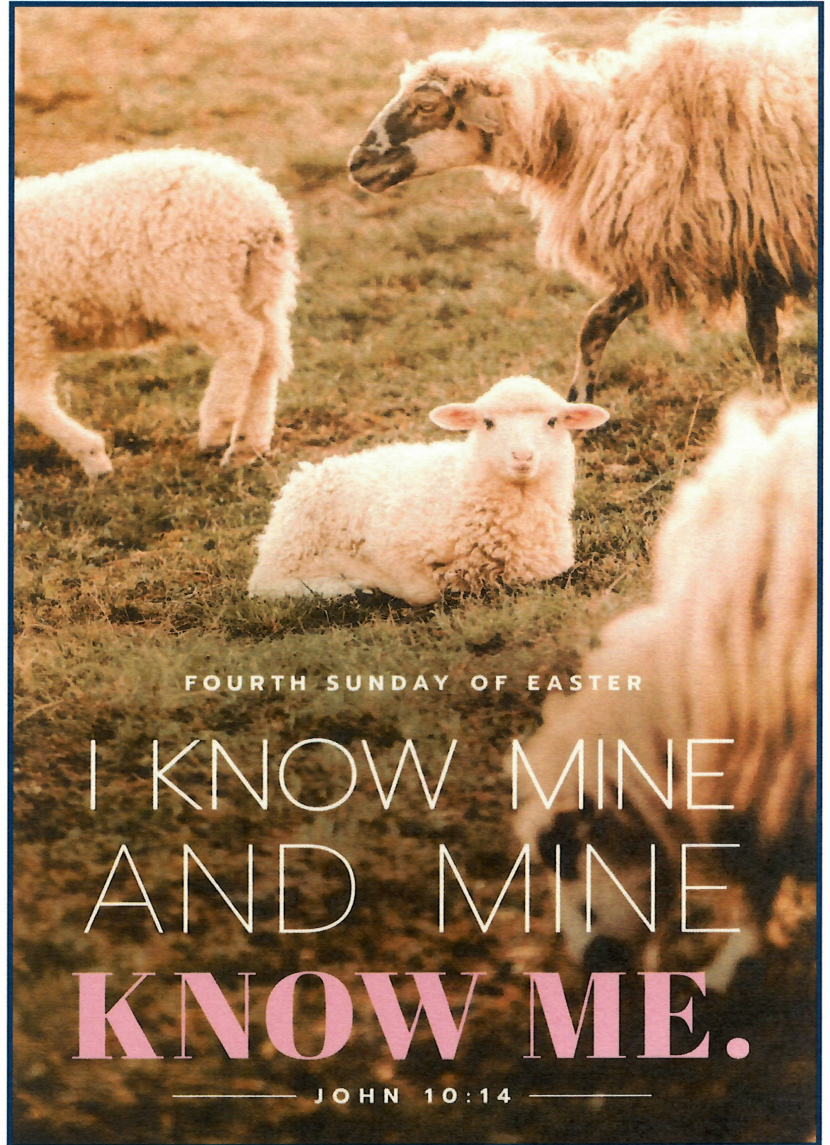

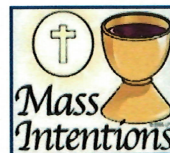

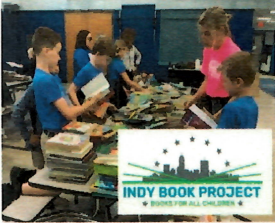




## Service Day 2024 - Power in Partnerships!

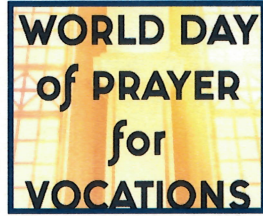

World Day of Prayer for Vocations

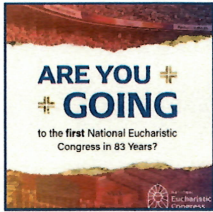

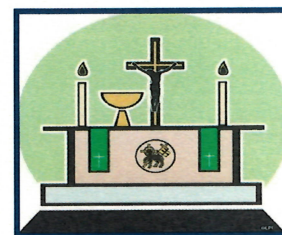
