Honduras Mission Trip

IHM began supporting Sister Maria Rosa's mission, founded in 1966 as Sociedad Amigos de los Ninos (SAN), in 2000 as part of a global outreach for our parish.



The mission trips consist of work projects balanced with plenty of playtime with Sister's children & fellowship with her adult staff. There are planned activities to continue building on our strong friendships that are fortified each year with our visits. Our group reflects on our experiences, in morning chapel discussions & in a day of sightseeing.

The first of week July, 8 young women and three adult women from IHM poured cement foundations for clotheslines, brought bags of food to very poor families in Flor Azul Village, did a mini home makeover on one of the children's homes, shared a canvas-painting workshop with Honduran women at a school for teenage domestic workers, painted t shirts with the teens, and hosted a 4th of July party for 100 children.

We appreciate her amazing generosity and dedication as she will continue to be an inspiration to others seeking to serve. We are blessed to have Ellie Dedinsky stepping up to take over this beloved outreach program. We are humbled by the commitment and selflessness of our parishoners.

Gospel Meditation

July 21, 2024

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Burnout can threaten anyone who tries to seriously serve and love others. How does our faith inform this challenging experience, and how do we find refreshment?

The apostles face something like burnout this week in Mark 6. They are run down from their missionary work, and Jesus says, "Come away by yourselves to a lonely place, and rest a while." For them, and for us, it takes humility to intentionally rest. It means the world can go on without us. It stings our pride to admit God is necessary and we are not. Choosing to leave our good work to be with him — whatever the cost — is an act of humble faith. And that trust in God begins to revive us.

But there's more to it. Hilariously, Mark tells us that throngs of needy people find out where the apostles are going and arrive ahead of them. Imagine the exasperation of the burnt-out apostles. "Can we please get a minute to ourselves? This is not healthy!" And Jesus seems to encourage the boundary violation by telling his frayed followers to feed the crowd. Look: once we move into humble rest, he calls us to more work, because we are made for love, not for rest. But Jesus does the vast bulk of the labor. He himself is the one who multiplies the small offering until everyone is satisfied.

What finally gives our heart rest isn't more vacation time. It's experiencing the super abundant generosity of God for us and those whom we serve.

For the 2024-25 school year, our cost to educate each child is over \$10,000.
