



St. Padre Pio~Feast Day September 23

Best known as Padre Pio, St. Pius was born Francesco Forgione in 1887 in Pietrelcina, Italy. As a young boy he suffered many illnesses. He joined Capuchin Franciscans at 15 and took the name of Pius or "Pio" in honor of Pope Pius I. He was ordained in 1910, and at this time he received the marks of stigmata, the wounds of Christ, but they eventually healed. He was assigned to the friary in San Giovanni Rotondo. In 1918, while continuing to serve at the friary, the stigmata appeared again, and this time remained until his death.

Padre Pio died at the age of eighty-one in 1968 and in 2002 Pope John Paul II proclaimed him "St. Pio of Pietrelcina."


Baptism



Walk with One

Connect in Eucharistic Friendship

After you've identified the person the Lord is calling you to walk with and prayed for this person, look for ways to build a deeper friendship with them.



"Eucharistic friendship" builds upon the dynamic that Jesus revealed in his relationships with the apostles and, above all, at the Last Supper—he TOOK bread, BLESSED it, BROKE it, and GAVE it.

As you spend time with the person you've identified, it's important to TAKE and receive what they share, BLESS and lift it up in prayer, allow the Holy Spirit to BREAK open opportunities to connect, and then GIVE of yourself in response.

Practically speaking, listen to your friend as they share their joys and struggles. Be interested in their life.

- ~Share your own joys and struggles when it's appropriate.
- ~Listen respectfully when the conversation turns to spiritual matters, including their relationship with God and any questions about the Church.
- ~Share your faith confidently and joyfully.



Note: Some people might be ready to discuss the spiritual life after only a conversation or two, while others might need more time. Therefore, stay connected to the Holy Spirit first and foremost!

Reflections - Gospel Meditation

When I was a wet-behind-the-ears seminarian, I was sent for an immersion with the poor. For one month, I lived in a home for adults with developmental disabilities. It was a challenge for me because the residents had significant communication issues. A 30-year-old man there named Robin was totally deaf and mute. He had Down's Syndrome. He looked like a Viking, with a shock of red hair and a fine beard. But I felt awkward and disconnected from him. All my normal ways of interacting failed. I resigned myself to the fact that we'd never connect.

Then one morning something amazing happened. He was on the living room floor quietly playing with toys. Watching him from a chair, I sensed Jesus' words float into my mind, "Whoever welcomes one such child in my name welcomes me, and whoever welcomes me welcomes not me but the one who sent me" (Mark 9:37). I thought, "Jesus, you must somehow be in Robin." I sheepishly made sure no one else was in the room, and then I spoke in a clear voice: "Jesus, are you there?" Robin did not turn to me and say, "Hi, John. Yes, it's me, Jesus." He kept playing with his toys in silence.

But something changed in me. From that moment on, it was easier to just be with Robin, to joke around with him, to try sign-language with him, to let him be himself, and for me to be myself. His "disabilities" were no longer obstacles to overcome. He became just Robin, my friend.




St. Dominic Mission Society is the foreign mission organization of the Dominican Friars of the Province of St. Albert the Great (Central USA). Our principal foreign mission

is in Puerto Rico. Due to Hurricane Maria in 2017 the roof of the Shrine of St. Martin de Porres in Cataño, Puerto Rico, is in need of major repair.

This weekend, September 21 & 22, Fr. Jerry Stookey will be presiding over all out Masses.

He was ordained a Dominican priest in 1978. He is the Director of St. Dominic Mission Society, the foreign mission office of the Dominican Friars. Fr. Jerry over 10 years of missionary experience in Nicaragua, Cuba, and Puerto Rico.


