




A person must be registered & active for 6 months BEFORE plans will be discussed or a date set.

All infant baptisms take place at one of the weekend Masses chosen by parents. One preparation class for first time parents is required. The next class will be held on Monday, February 2, 2026 from 7:30-9:00pm. New parents are encouraged to attend prior to the birth of the child. **Gospel Meditation****Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture**

This week we hear that John the Baptist is out in the wilderness eating **"locusts and wild honey"** (Mark 1:6). It's not just a strange historical detail. It's a symbolic expression of a healthy spiritual diet. The path to Christ includes both the hard and the beautiful, the gritty and the sweet. We have to learn to gulp the locusts and savor the honey.

I remember working with a young couple preparing for marriage. They were sincere, but raw — barely beginning to discover faith. Part of me wanted to rush them ahead, to fill in all the gaps, to bombard them with scripture and church documents. I swallowed that instinct. It was like eating locusts.

But I also recall them light up as they spoke about each other, about their first child, then their second. And they wanted to be close to God. Something innocent and beautiful was unfolding. That was the honey. I knew God was asking me to savor it.

This Advent, maybe we're each being invited to accept both locusts and honey. Maybe it's time to stop avoiding the difficult parts of faith — prayer that feels dry, the call to repentance, the patience with the troublesome. It's time to eat some locusts.

But we also need to notice the small gifts God gives us: a peaceful moment, a good conversation, the joy of serving someone else, new life, good intentions of our friends. That's the honey. Savor it!

John didn't avoid either. He took it all in. And so can we. What are your locusts? Your honey? If we let God feed us with both, we'll be ready — really ready — for the coming of Christ.

OCIA

Sunday, December 7 at the 9:30 Mass, OCIA Catechumens & Candidates will participate in the Rites of Entrance and Welcome.

The Rite of Entrance is for those who have never been baptized. They state their intention to respond to God's call to follow the way of Christ. The Church, in turn, accepts them into the Order of Catechumens (a Greek word meaning 'hearers'). "From this time on, the Church embraces the catechumens as its own, with a mother's love and concern. Joined to the Church, the catechumens are now part of the household of Christ, since the Church nourishes them with the word of God and sustains them by means of liturgical celebrations" (OCIA, 47).

The Rite of Welcoming is for baptized but uncatechized adults who are seeking to complete their Christian Initiation through the Sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist or to be received into the full communion of the Catholic Church. This rite acknowledges that these candidates are already part of the community because they have been marked by Baptism. Now the Church surrounds them with special care and support as they prepare to be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit in Confirmation and take their place at the banquet table of Christ's sacrifice. (OCIA, 411-412)

Please pray for our catechumens and candidates as they continue their preparation towards the Easter Vigil.








When Mary appeared to Juan Diego as Our Lady of Guadalupe, she had encouraging words for him. "Am I not here, I who am your mother?"

In the image on Juan Diego's tilma (tunic), Mary identifies herself with the Aztec people. She has their hair and features, their symbolic maternity dress. She incorporated their important symbols of the sun, moon, and stars. Today's Mass includes two Gospel options. Both are familiar passages from the Gospel of Luke - the Annunciation and the Visitation. Both are equally relevant to today's feast because Mary's yes to Christ isn't only to care for him but to come to us. Our Lady of Guadalupe is pregnant. The image bears witness to Mary's yes to conceive the Savior of the World. But even in her pregnancy, she goes to care for Elizabeth. Now Mother to all the world, Mary comes to the aid of her children, reminding them of her presence among them.
